Mr. Heyl introduced the training by stating that the Board training is one of the requirements under the Borough's MS4 permit and that this will help the Borough to stay in compliance. Mr. Wingrove displayed a PowerPoint training presentation explaining that Dormont is a Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System and is therefore subject to the DEP MS4 regulations. He went through the educational presentation (attached) and asked for questions. There was a short discussion about enforcement around what is being put into the storm sewers – things like washing out concrete trucks and car washing in the streets. The stormwater ordinance probably should be enforced by the Borough – but a good working relationship with the Borough staff and code enforcement is important so that there is good communication about violations that affect our MS4 permitting. Mr. Heyl stated that there would be flow monitoring done over the next couple weeks as part of the MS4 permit. Ms. Grass reminded everyone that there will be a public education workshop on July 21 featuring great speakers from Stormworks, Audobon of W. PA, and Tree Pittsburgh.
