
FROM THE AUTHORITY BOARD AND STAFF!

WE BUILT A RAIN GARDEN

In summer of 2022, we built a rain garden in the W. Liberty Avenue parking lot. The Authority hopes to construct several more rain gardens around the Borough to reduce stormwater and control flooding and overflows. Urban Plantscapes has been hired to maintain it.

LET'S PLANT SOME TREES IN '23

The Authority will be working with the Borough's Shade Tree Commission and Tree Pittsburgh to offer residents free trees and technical assistance for planting in front yards within the Borough right- of-way.
