Comments from the Solicitor: The Solicitor announced that, in the absence of the Chairperson, she will conduct the meeting.

Treasurers Report: The Solicitor reported that current collections for the month of December were \$17,859.36; delinquent collections were \$2,148.67; the balance in the PLGIT Operating Account as of December 31 was \$802,631.55. The bill list is in the amount of \$10,053.00. The total collection rate through December 31 is 92.4%. Interest income with PLGIT is now over \$38,000.

Engineer's Report: John Heyl, LSSE, reported that Add Alternate Nol 2 and Add Alternate No. 3 for the Piedmont Avenue project have been completed and a partial payment request has been submitted for the amount of \$94,491. Draft plans were reviewed with the Board for Piedmont Avenue Phase 2 and for the Espy Avenue Rain Garden. The Advertisement will be prepared for a bid opening in February. The LSA grant requesting funds for the Dormont Park TMDL grant was submitted November 30. The GEDTF grant

requesting additional funds for the TMDL project has already been submitted. The MS4 DEP inspection is scheduled for January 30. The Engineer is coordinating with the Borough for the 2024 road paving projects and may recommend storm sewer work on Texas Avenue between Elyria Alley and Mississippi Avenue. There are also 2 inlets on Key Avenue that should be replaced.

Solicitor Report: The Solicitor had no report at this time.

Manager's Report: Grass reported that the 2024 budget, capital plan, and meeting schedule have been published. The Authority was notified that they have received a Small Water and Sewer grant in the amount of \$200,000 for the TMDL project at Dormont Park and in the process of contracting. She will coordinate with the Borough Manager to have a meeting with the new Council members to bring them up to date. There is an action item on the agenda to authorize the Engineer to prepare the specifications and advertisement for the TMDL project. She is coordinating activities with the Borough for the DEP inspection scheduled for January 30. The team began to prepare financials for the annual audit.
